KIWITM is a communication and data publishing application combining a HTTP Web Server, Web configuration tools, multi-site manager, ODBC interface and security system in a single product. With KIWITM, you can design any type of dynamic website based on any database with an ODBC driver*, restrict data access by user, publish text or images, create unlimited numbers of pages, and all this can be installed, configured and running within a day. You can change the layouts and links any time you wish through a simple user interface.

Quite simply, KIWITM has been developed to provide an easy to use, cost effective way of instantly publishing your important information without high IT overheads and large development costs.

KIWI Features

Setup and Maintenance

KIWITM is an integrated, double clickable application which incorporates a powerful web server, an interface that can interrogate any database with an ODBC driver, a user authentication system, website design and configuration interface and generic web page templates.

Installation is as simple as copying the application and associated files onto the computer that will host the web site. You will need to configure your network or computer security to allow web browser requests.

Configuration is simply a matter of deciding on the database you wish to publish, who can see what, what data should appear on what pages, what images and text you want on your pages. A site with a few simple pages can be set up and published within minutes. A complex site like those costing many tens of thousands of dollars can be operational in a matter of hours.

The system is virtually maintenance free.

What Can You Show

Basically, anything you want. Up to Date Catalogues for Customers, Work in Progress to Clients and Resellers, Inventory to Sales People, Outstanding Orders to Suppliers, and so on. It is only limited by your imagination and your business needs. If the data is in your database it can be published.

How Does it Work

There are three basic interfaces, a menu, a list and a detail page. You can configure one menu, as many lists as you wish and as many detail pages as you wish.

Through the user friendly interface you can see a list of all the databases running on your system. You select the one you wish to publish.

Creating a List or Detail Page is simply a matter of associating fields in your database with columns or positions on the web pages. This is achieved through a simple drag and drop interface.



How Does it Work (cont.)

Links can be established from a menu item to a list to a detail page, providing infinite possibilities.

And all this can be reconfigured in moments. You can adapt the design and function of your site at any time according to your ideas, or the wishes of your customers or users.

You can even work on your new site off line whilst your old site is being published, then switch to the new site with one click when you're ready.

Web Interface

Generic Web Pages are provided with the application. These pages can be configured through KIWITM to provide a customised look without any HTML knowledge. You can place corporate logo's, images, colours and text in a variety of predetermined locations.

Of course, if you want to go even further, advanced users can fully customise the web pages with any HTML editor.

Security

A sophisticated security system is built into the software. Access can only be gained with a valid username and password. The user names and passwords can be kept on your database or in KIWITM's own security files. You set the data filter for each user.

When viewing data, the browser address bars and buttons are deactivated. The users never see your database, only the data that KIWITM extracts. Once in the system, users can only see the data you have authorised.
